Week 1	
June 1-7 – PRAISE & THANKSGIVING <i>"Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever." Psalm 107:1 (NIV)</i>	
Mon 1	Praise God for the estimated 1-3 million Christian converts from Islam in Iran. Praise God that despite intense persecution, the underground church in Iran remains one of the fastest-growing in the world. Continue to pray for peace in the region and God's comfort for those who are grieving, have been displaced, or living in fear.
Tue 2	Praise GOD for the countless Muslims encountering Christ through dreams and visions. Give thanks for testimonies like the Saudi Arabian woman who, while tending sheep in the desert, saw a reflection of a massive smiling Shepherd in a pool of water. After she asked Jesus to heal her crippled mother as proof, her mother immediately stood up and walked, leading her to shout, "Jesus, I believe!"
Wed 3	Praise GOD for the upcoming Muslim Background Believers (MBB) Conference. Give thanks for the growing global network of MBBs who are finding fellowship, receiving teaching, and being equipped to reach their own communities. Pray for protection, unity, and encouragement for all who will attend.
Thu 4	Praise GOD for YWAM's Oral Mother Tongue (OMT) Translation movement bringing the Bible to people in their own spoken language through audio recordings on microSD cards, reaching communities where literacy is low and written Bibles have never existed. S., one of the OMT translators working in South Asia, describes what happens when people hear the Word of God in their mother tongue for the first time: <i>"They feel alive! They feel like God is personally talking to them and doesn't just feel like a distant religion or a distant God."</i>
Fri 5	Praise GOD for the resilience of believers in restricted nations. Give thanks that even in places where the church is pushed entirely underground, the light of Christ cannot be extinguished.
Sat-Sun 6-7	Praise GOD for digital media and satellite television. Give thanks that platforms like SAT-7 and Iran Alive Ministries continue to broadcast the Gospel 24/7, reaching millions of Muslims in their living rooms where traditional missionaries cannot go. Pray for God's provision for this vital ministry.
Week 2	
June 8-14 – PRAY FOR MUSLIM PEOPLE <i>"The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance." 2 Peter 3:9 (NIV)</i>	
Mon 8	Pray for Muslims who are secretly exploring the Christian faith. Ask God to provide them with safe communities, mentors, and discipleship networks where they can grow in truth and courage without fear of reprisal. Pray that they will have access to His word in their heart languages.
Tue 9	Pray for Muslim women and children who often face marginalization and hardship. Pray for women like Mona from Syria, who endured childhood marriage and abuse before fleeing to Lebanon as a refugee. At a local church, she heard the story of Christ's suffering and realized, "Jesus died for me, He loves me!" She and her husband are now baptized and boldly sharing their faith.
Wed 10	Pray for Muslims living in regions affected by instability and conflict. Pray that the compassionate outreach of local believers would demonstrate Christ's love in tangible ways. Yassir Eric was a radical Muslim from Sudan who came to faith after two Egyptian Coptic Christians prayed for his dying Muslim cousin in hospital and was miraculously healed. He also later discovered that the Christian classmate he had nearly beaten to death years earlier had written his name on the front page of his Bible and prayed for him faithfully all along.
Thu 11	Pray that media ministries and digital outreach efforts would successfully break through barriers of censorship, fear, and misunderstanding. Pray that Muslims tuning into Christian broadcasts or reading scripture online would experience the convicting power of the Holy Spirit.
Fri 12	Pray for Muslims who have recently immigrated to Western countries. Pray that they would encounter the love of Christ through the hospitality and genuine friendship of local believers.
Sat-Sun 13-14	Pray for Muslim background believers (MBBs) who face intense pressure, rejection from families, and severe persecution for their faith. Pray for the Holy Spirit to grant them supernatural endurance, physical protection, and a deep sense of joy in their salvation.

Week 3	May 15-21 – PRAY FOR THE CHURCH AND THE LABOURERS <i>"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Matthew 28:19 (NIV)</i>
Mon 15	Pray for missionaries and field workers serving in emotionally taxing and spiritually hostile Muslim contexts. Assembly of God missionaries recently reported that Muslims are responding to Jesus at levels 'we have never seen, not in 1,400 years!' Pray that these workers would be continually refreshed by witnessing this unprecedented harvest, and that the global church would faithfully stand with them in prayer.
Tue 16	Pray for the protection and provision of local and indigenous believers who are leading underground house churches and discipleship movements. Ask God to grant them wisdom, discernment, and boldness in sharing the Gospel amidst surveillance and danger. Pray that they would remain steadfast in their faith.
Wed 17	Pray for unity, mutual encouragement, and strong partnerships between international missionaries and local national workers. Pray that their shared vision for reaching the unreached would bear abundant fruit.
Thu 18	Pray for ministries working with refugees and displaced persons from Muslim-majority countries. Pray that workers would be equipped with cultural understanding, language skills, and relational sensitivity to effectively minister to trauma-affected communities.
Fri 19	Pray for the families and children of missionaries serving in restricted access nations. Ask God to protect their minds and hearts, provide for their educational and social needs, and give them a profound sense of purpose in their family's calling. Pray they would experience deep joy, unity, and God's peace as they serve together.
Sat-Sun 20-21	Pray that God would raise up a new generation of laborers, missionaries, and leaders from within Muslim-background communities. Pray that they would be empowered to take the Gospel deeper into unreached and unengaged people groups. May God strengthen and sustain them as they boldly proclaim Christ.
Week 4	May 22-31 – PRAY FOR A MUSLIM REGION <i>Nine rooms in the house of Islam: Western South Asia</i>
Mon 22	Pray for the millions of Afghan refugees who have fled to neighboring countries like Pakistan and Iran, only to face deportation, instability, and uncertainty. Pray that in their displacement, they would encounter the love and truth of Jesus Christ. Pray also for boldness for believers ministering among them throughout the region.
Tue 23	Pray for hidden believers living under Taliban rule, like Khada. After her husband was tortured and killed for their shared Christian faith, Khada found comfort in Ephesians 6. Though she misses reading the Bible with him at night, she says, "Now, all my conversations are with Jesus... I believe that He is listening." Pray for her.
Wed 24	Pray for the Pashtun people, one of the largest unreached people groups in the world. With over 12 million Afghan Tajiks and millions of Pashtuns having virtually no followers of Jesus, pray for pioneer workers to bring the Gospel to these frontier groups.
Thu-Fri 25-26	Pray for the massive unreached populations in Pakistan, including the 17 million Jat (Muslim traditions) and 11 million Arain. Pray that God would raise up laborers to work among these groups where there is currently no resident witness for Christ. Pray for Christians and religious minorities in Pakistan who face constant threat from strict blasphemy laws. Pray for those currently imprisoned or on death row under false accusations, and for protection against vigilante mob violence and unlawful evictions.
Sat-Sun 27-28	Pray for Christians and Muslims in India facing increasing persecution and violence from Hindu nationalist policies. Pray for protection against mob attacks, forced conversions, and anti-conversion laws that target religious minorities in 13 states.
Mon-Tue 29-30	Pray for India, which is home to over 2,000 unreached people groups—the most of any country in the world. Pray specifically for the Ansari (10.8 million) and Bengali Muslims, that access to the Gospel would increase in practical and profound ways.
