June 1-7 – PRAISE & THANKSGIVING	
<i>"I will give thanks to you, Lord, with all my heart; I will tell all of your wonderful deeds."</i> Psalm 9:1 NIV	
Week 1	
Sun 1	Praise GOD for His word—not only does it transform the hearts of the recipients, but they have an incredible ripple effect as well, with the Good News spreading out into their communities. One organization reports that they were able to get more Bibles into the hands of evangelists and pastors from Kenya, India and Indonesia.
Mon 2	Praise GOD for hopeful signs of progress among the Northern Yemeni people. Thousands have downloaded the online Bible in the Northern Yemeni dialect since its release this year despite having limited internet access. One man came to faith after reading about Isa and the Hebrew scriptures referenced in the Qur'an.
Tue 3	Praise GOD for the ministry of Youth for Christ Lebanon. The youth from the Manara Youth Center's spiritual program are on their pivotal moment in their Alpha journey. Alpha introduces young people to the core truths of Christianity. Pray for these youth as they explore what it means to have a personal relationship with Jesus.
Wed 4	Praise GOD for audio Bibles! A woman in Mozambique was listening to the audio Bible and playing it loudly while she was working in her croplands. A man who overheard became curious and asked the lady about it. In the end, he wanted an audio Bible for himself as well. Pray that there will be more people in Mozambique and other tribes in the 10/40 window who will have access to audio Bibles in their heart languages.
Thu 5	Praise GOD for a reprieve in the situation in Syria as the EU just lifted economic sanctions against this struggling nation. Despite the threat of persecution, many Christians choose to stay for the sake of Christ. Alawite and Druze minorities are responding to the gospel more than ever. Pray for their protection as they learn more about Jesus and pray for strength and encouragement for the believers who are choosing to stay.
Fri-Sat 6-7	Praise GOD for the growing church among the Nuri people! There are tens of thousands of Nuri believers in dozens of unregistered churches facing persecution, arrest, and targeted attacks. Despite increasing scrutiny and harassment, many Nuristanis are coming to Jesus. Pray that many more will hear about Jesus.
June 8-14 – PRAY FOR MUSLIM PEOPLE	
<i>"...the time is coming when anyone who kills you will think they are offering a service to God. They will do such things because they have not known the Father or me."</i> John 16:2-3 NIV	
Week 2	
Sun 8	A new Christian from a Muslim background is facing threats and interrogation by the secret police. She and her family are refugees in an Arab country but have been selected for resettlement to a western country. Recently, she began to receive threats from other refugees because of her faith. Pray the Lord's comfort and protection for N. May those around N. see God's hand at work in her life in the midst of her challenges.
Mon 9	Luri people are a group of nomadic shepherds who live in the Zagros Mountains of southwestern Iran. The Luri are Shia Muslims but unlike many of the Shia who are dogmatic in their beliefs, the Luri have adopted a more practical belief system. Pray that church planting movements would begin among this nomadic people.
Tue 10	In Paris, about one out of three cafes are owned by Berbers from northern Algeria. Majority of Paris taxi drivers and many small grocery stores are owned by Berbers. So many opportunities for Christians to engage Berbers and earn the right to share Jesus. Pray for Christians in France to have the heart for the Berbers.
Wed 11	The Jordanian gov't. stripped the Muslim Brotherhood of all its assets because of an alleged plot threatening national security. One less player to fight against the work of the gospel in Jordan. Continue to pray for God to work in the hearts of those aligned with radical Islam. Pray that more people will hear the gospel!
Thu 12	Shaikhs are the largest group of unreached Muslims in the world. Even though they are not an ethnic group and don't share a common language, they share a common history, caste, and religious tradition. God has been moving across South Asia for decades. But there are no known movements to Christ among the Shaikhs in Pakistan, India or Bangladesh. Yet. Pray that God will break down barriers and open hearts to receive Jesus!
Fri-Sat 13-14	The Shia Muslim Hazara of Afghanistan have been the recipients of attacks by Afghan Sunni Muslims for centuries. Some Hazara have settled in cities, but the majority still have nomadic lifestyles. Pray for Christians who will reach them with the gospel. Pray that they will experience true love and acceptance in Jesus.

Week 3	June 15-21 – PRAY FOR THE CHURCH AND THE LABOURERS <i>"I am willing to endure anything if it will bring salvation and eternal glory in Christ Jesus to those God has chosen." 2 Timothy 2:10 NIV</i>
Sun 15	For centuries Christian missionaries have been sent from North America (NA) to the world, but now the world is sending missionaries back to NA for such a time as this when God is sending the nations to our doorsteps--- among them, Muslim people who remain one of the most spiritually neglected mission fields. We are called to love not to fear our Muslim neighbors. Pray that God would awaken His people and give us a sense of urgency.
Mon 16	You might have asked at one point in the past few years why Iran's church is growing so rapidly? There is much to say about open hearts and the powerful move of the Spirit. But one strand of the tapestry is that many Persian speakers outside Iran are coming to faith and then sharing the Gospel with loved ones back home in Iran. This is such an encouragement for us as we witness to the Muslims God has brought in our communities.
Tue 17	M. is a brother in Christ living in Pakistan, where Christians live as second-class citizens and often face job discrimination, rape, abductions, blasphemy charges, and even death. When M. inherited land from his father, a Muslim man who had leased the land for several years claimed the land was his. When M. challenged him, the man and several other Muslims severely beat M. Praise God for the Christians helping M. Pray for him!
Wed 18	Christian siblings who were driven out of Iran are now seeking asylum in the US. Both their asylum claims were denied. If no country offers protection, they will be forced back to Iran where they can face imprisonment, torture, or even death. Pray for them and many other Christian asylum seekers who are seeking a safe haven.
Thu 19	According to VOM* Canada, Christians' identity cards in Malaysia are now being marked as "Muslim" as their religious designation. It's a more forced conversion with a clear agenda to shift the religious and political landscape toward Sharia law. Pray for Christians who are continuing to share the gospel despite this new dev't.
Fri-Sat 20-21	In South Asia, neighbours with cursed relatives go to a Christian missionary's house asking for prayer. "We find it encouraging when one Muslim encourages another Muslim to go to the Christian for prayer. It's common occurrence for Muslims to knock on our door asking for prayers!" Prayer is a Christian's most powerful weapon.

Week 4	June 22-30 – PRAY FOR A MUSLIM REGION <i>Nine rooms in the house of Islam: East Africa</i>
Sun 22	East Africa is immensely diverse, and Islam is on the rise. It claims to have the answers to truth and life. But Jesus alone is the way, the truth, and the life for every East African. Pray that His love be multiplied in this region. Pray that His peace be poured out in this region. Pray for the salvation of many Muslims in this region!
Mon 23	What is the largest non-Arabic ethnic group between the Nile River and the Red Sea? The Bejas! One subgroup, the Hedareb, are nomadic shepherds who live in the desert regions of Sudan, Egypt and Eritrea. Pray that the Lord will raise up missionaries who are willing to go to the Beja and invest their lives to reach these nomads.
Tue 24	While some Sudanese Arabs now live in the city chasing economic prosperity, many still live a nomadic lifestyle moving from place to place with their herds. The men gather in the local mosque five times a day for prayer while women meet in homes and have their own religious services conducted by female religious leaders. Pray for a Christian witness among the women who may be used by the Lord to lead their families to Jesus.
Wed-Thu 25-26	While Kenya is predominantly Christian, in Mombasa, Muslims make up 40% of the population and the Mijikenda people (with 0.1% or less Christian) make up almost 35% of these Muslims. They follow a mix of Muslim and animistic beliefs. Pray for breakthroughs and a hunger for His Word among the Mijikenda people.
Fri-Sat 27-28	The Yao are a predominantly Muslim ethnic group with villages in Malawi, Mozambique, Tanzania, and Zambia. Their faith influences everything in their lives, including a cultural expectation to live by the laws of Islam. One Yao listener of FEBC** said, "For many years, we have seen Christianity as a threat. After listening to FEBC radio, we are grateful to acknowledge our ignorance and we have now accepted Jesus in our lives." Pray!
Sun-Mon 29-30	Workers in Mozambique are requesting prayers for H., a Muslim friend they visit and with whom they share the Word. Pray for the family and especially for his wife who has recently been sick. Pray this family will respond to the Gospel. Mozambique has also gone through severe unrest in recent months. Pray for the safety of workers and for peace to be restored to this nation.
