September 1-7 – PRAISE & THANKSGIVING	
Week 1	<i>"He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end." Ecclesiastes 3:11 NIV</i>
Mon 1	<b>Praise God</b> for His people who are proclaiming the gospel to Muslims. A story: Two missionaries found themselves among 30,000 Muslims attending a convention. They engaged people in conversations and by the end of the event, they were grateful to have had seven meaningful, gospel-focused conversations. Imagine if each one of His children intentionally befriended one or two Muslim people. Pray for a bold witness.
Tue 2	<b>Praise GOD</b> for the quiet and lasting influence of His people in the mission field. Although these brave believers serve in the shadows and many of us will never know their names, the Lord does and their impact in the Kingdom is eternal. Pray that they are receiving much love, support, and encouragement from the church.
Wed 3	<b>Praise GOD</b> for a successful summer camp and ministry season at YFC Lebanon. "This ministry was never carried by staff alone. It was carried by homes that gave, adjusted, and prayed. And now, we ask God to pour rest and blessing on those homes too." It's a great reminder to pray and lift up the workers' support system.
Thu 4	<b>Praise GOD</b> for how the Lord has multiplied a couple's efforts over the years in the world's largest Muslim-majority country. The couple continues to visit the country to train and multiply local believers even though they are now back in their home country, dealing with death in the family and health issues. Pray for them.
Fri 5	<b>Praise GOD</b> that He is growing His Church in a very difficult place like Afghanistan. Thousands of Afghans started following Radio Mojdeh on Instagram this summer. Pray that God would make the gospel of Jesus Christ an unavoidable issue for Afghans. Pray for the many Afghan Christians, for their protection and safety.
Sat-Sun 6-7	<b>Praise GOD</b> for the different radio broadcast programs in the 10/40 window that reach the unsaved with the Gospel and strengthen believers in their faith. Pray for these media ministries that they would be faithful to preach the Word of God— correcting, rebuking, and encouraging in all seasons (2 Timothy 4:2).
September 8-14 – PRAY FOR MUSLIM PEOPLE	
Week 2	<i>"Jesus said, 'My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my arrest by the Jewish leaders. But now my kingdom is from another place.'" John 18:36 NIV</i>
Mon 8	A field worker shared that while he was in a bookstore in South Asia, he came across the book <b>Means of Salvation</b> by Ali Muhammad Choudhary in which he read, "Forgiveness for mankind is <i>conditional</i> with the acceptance of the magnificence of the Holy Prophet, which should be the primary belief." This exultation of Muhammad in Islam has taken the place of Jesus' sinless life and His substitutionary death on the cross.
Tue 9	Muslims believe the lie that Jesus was not crucified and that he did not die on the cross. Pray that Christians will be bold to declare that "the very heart of Christianity, its center and its cynosure, its pivot and power, is the atonement wrought by Christ on the cross." Pray we will persevere and not waver in sharing this TRUTH.
Wed 10	In Southeast Asia, there are around 277 million Muslims, 88% of them are Sunni Muslims. Many young people from Brunei and Indonesia travel abroad to study, mostly to UK, Australia, and Canada. Pray that they will meet Jesus followers who will share their faith with them and lead them to a relationship with Jesus.
Thu 11	When Mohammed died in A.D. 632, Arabs erupted from the desert pastures of Arabia and overran the lands east and west. They intermarried with the local North African tribes and introduced them to Islam. One of these "Arabized" tribes are the Amri people of Sudan where there are no known Jesus followers. Pray that Sudanese Christians will have a burden to reach the Amri people with the gospel and pray for open hearts.
Fri 12	In the Sahel, 95% of the 100 million people are Muslim adherents. Per Lausanne: "The Sahel is also an area in which pioneer evangelism, Bible translation, and church planting are most challenging and most needed." Many of these countries experience political instability and violence, which lead to hardships for the people. Pray for peace in the Sahel region. Pray for Christians here to be salt and light in this region.
Sat-Sun 13-14	The Horn of Africa has over 140 million Muslim adherents. Although Christianity has taken root among the Omotic and Ethio-semitic people groups, the Beja and Somali people groups are still unreached. The region is plagued by conflict, famine, and displacement, creating immense physical and emotional suffering. Christians have provided humanitarian aid in the region but pray that this would open doors for the gospel.

Week 3	September 15-21 – PRAY FOR THE CHURCH AND THE LABOURERS <i>“Do not be afraid of what you are about to suffer. I tell you, the devil will put some of you in prison to test you.... Be faithful, even to the point of death, and I will give you life as your victor’s crown.” Rev 2:10 NIV</i>
Mon 15	A new report shows that four of the world’s five most populous countries systematically persecute Christians. Believers in China, India, Pakistan, and Indonesia are resolute in faith despite attacks across societal levels (around 35% of the world’s Muslims live in these countries). Pray that the Holy Spirit would strengthen and comfort persecuted believers. Pray that God will raise more workers into areas of great need and opportunity.
Tue 16	Over 7,000 Christians in Nigeria have been killed this year. According to the Voice of the Martyrs, the violence has left farms and roads unsafe and people fearful. Even so, Christians are training Fulani believers to reach their own people with the Gospel. Pray for the Church in Nigeria to be a bold witness of faith in the fire.
Wed 17	Tensions in Syria are rising, and the Druze and Christians are caught in the middle. Pierre Housney with Horizons International says the Druze have formed a militia for protection. Pray for protection and courage for Christians facing persecution and pray for a Christian witness among the Druze so they may know Jesus.
Thu 18	In areas where the country’s political situation is always shifting and unstable, workers are learning to rely on God in every situation. “We don’t trust in horses and chariots. We don’t trust in drones and Uncle Sam. We trust in the Lord,” a worker said. May the Lord protect the workers and provide for their every need!
Fri 19	A couple who has been faithfully ministering within a Muslim-majority community in southern Ethiopia was in the process of building a church when a mob stormed into the compound. They dismantled the shelter and stole all their materials. Instead of helping, the police threw the couple in prison instead. Intercede for them!
Sat-Sun 20-21	Somewhere in East Africa, a female is quietly leading a one-woman outreach through her work as a nurse. While serving in local hospitals, she uses her medical skills as a bridge to reach women and children with the hope of the gospel. Her steadfast presence has led to secret conversions and the formation of underground believer networks in previously unreached areas. Remember the workers serving in hard-to-reach areas.

Week 4	September 22-31 – PRAY FOR A MUSLIM REGION <i>Nine rooms in the house of Islam: Turkestan</i>
Mon 22	David Garrison, author of “A Wind in the House of Islam” said that the Turkestan region has seen very little movement to Christ compared to regions like Sub-Saharan Africa or the Persian World. But God... According to Revival Journal**, evangelical churches—once primarily sowed by Russian, German, and other immigrant Christians—are now growing significantly, with mostly Uzbek and Tajik believers attending.
Tue 23	In the Greater Caucasus region, there are around 23 million Shia and Sunni Muslims, with less than 1% Christian adherents and many people groups still unreached. Pray that God will open doors in this region and people would have the opportunity to hear about God’s love and would be moved to respond to God’s invitation.
Wed 24	A couple encountered a woman thirsty to know more about Jesus. She specifically asked them about Jesus and asked for a Bible. The couple was able to give her a Bible thanks to field workers who had been discreetly giving Bibles to other Christians in a closed country. Pray for God to open this person’s heart to the gospel. This lady is reading the Bible in her language. There is a lot of interest for Bibles in this country, praise God!
Thu-Fri 25-26	A Turkmen-language version of the radio series The Way of Righteousness (TWOR) is being broadcast in Central Asia. A film titled The King of Glory was scheduled to air in Turkmen on satellite TV—a rare and potentially powerful gospel resource in a highly closed country. Ask for hearts that are ready to receive!
Sat-Sun 27-28	In another closed area, a woman, once devoutly Muslim, received healing of body and soul through the testimony and prayer of believers—giving her hope and peace. She now leads and shares in an underground church. Pray for this dear lady. May the Lord protect her and continue to use her mightily.
Mon-Tue 29-30	A, a post-secondary student in Central Asia, is just one of the many persecuted Christians who faces hostility for his faith. He shared, “My roommates asked me why I did not pray Muslim prayers and why I was different. I shared about my faith and they asked me so many questions.” The school officials found out so A. was forced to transfer to another college. Pray that A. will continue to stand strong in his faith in his new school.
